**CJA COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT ORDER**

On November 6, 2019, the Judicial Council of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit approved the Criminal Justice Act Plan ("CJA Plan") for the Eastern District of Virginia. Section VIII(A)(1) of the CJA Plan provides that the Court, in consultation with the Federal Public Defender, shall appoint three divisional CJA Committees that shall consist of one district judge, one magistrate judge, one federal public defender attorney, two CJA Panel attorneys and an *ex officio* staff member employed by the Clerk's Office. By order of December 18, 2019, a copy of which is attached, the Court appointed divisional CJA Committees across the district for three-year terms. In the Norfolk/Newport News Divisions, the Court initially appointed CJA attorney Andrew Behrns to serve on the committee. However, in light of Mr. Behrns' change of practice and request to be removed from the Committee, effective immediately, the CJA Committee appoints Shawn M. Cline to serve the remainder of the unexpired term of Mr. Behrns. Mr. Cline shall be eligible for reappointment to another term.
