NOTICE TO APPLICANTS FOR ADMISSION TO PRACTICE

The application must be filed with the Civil Division of the Clerk's Office well in advance of the admission date, but must be in the Clerk's Office no later than the business day preceding the scheduled admission. A copy of the applicant's Virginia bar card must be attached to the application.

The \$150.00 admission fee (made payable to "Clerk, U.S. District Court") is due at the time of admission. The Clerk is prohibited from accepting it in advance. The fee for a certificate of good standing is \$15.00.
