

**NOTICE FOR REAPPOINTMENT OF
INCUMBENT MAGISTRATE JUDGE**

The current term of office of United States Magistrate Judge Tommy E. Miller at Norfolk and Newport News, Virginia, is due to expire on September 7, 2011. The United States District Court is required by law to establish a panel of citizens to consider the reappointment of the magistrate judge to a new eight-year term.

The duties of the magistrate judge position include the following: (1) trial and disposition of civil cases upon consent of the litigants; (2) conducting various pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings in civil cases, on delegation from the judges of the district court; (3) conducting most preliminary proceedings in criminal cases; and (4) trial and disposition of criminal misdemeanor cases.

Comments from members of the bar and the public are invited as to whether the incumbent magistrate judge should be recommended by the panel for reappointment by the court and should be directed to:
