PRETRIAL ORDER #2
Appointing Co-Lead Counsel and
Setting Lead Counsel Status Conference

Pursuant to the Initial Order, Pretrial Order #1, issued by this Court on November 30, 2016 [Doc. No. 2], the Court has received a Motion to Appoint Plaintiffs' Co-Lead Counsel [Doc. No. 10], which is supported by every counsel of record in the cases transferred as of the date that Motion was filed, as well as a Notice of Appointment of Lead Counsel for Lumber Liquidators, Inc. [Doc. No. 8]. The Initial Order permitted applications and nominations to be made on or before January 9, 2017 with any objections thereto to be filed on or before January 16, 2017. Therefore, upon consideration of the Motion and Notice and no objections having been filed with respect to the appointment to those positions, it is hereby

ORDERED that the following be, and the same hereby are, conditionally appointed and shall serve as Plaintiffs' Co-Lead Counsel subject to the Court's order confirming the appointment of Lead Counsel after the expiration of the nomination and objection periods on January 9, 2017 and January 16, 2017, respectively:

ORDERED that the Court will hold a status conference with Lead Counsel on **Friday, February 24, 2017, at 2:00 p.m.**, for the purpose of reviewing the status of the matters required to be accomplished before the Initial Status Conference and Rule 16(b) Conference on March 13, 2017, as set forth in the Court's Initial Order, Pretrial Order #1, as well as any other matters or issues that may need to be resolved or addressed, which Co-Lead Counsel shall described in a report to the Court filed on or before **Friday, February 17, 2017**. Only one of the designated Co-Lead Counsel for Plaintiffs is required to attend the status conference on February 24, 2017. The status conference with Lead Counsel will be held in open court and all counsel may attend, although no other counsel is expected or is required to attend; and a transcript of that status conference will be made available after the hearing; and it is further

CLARIFIED that the Initial Status Conference and Rule 16(b) Conference scheduled to take place on March 13, 2017 will take place at 2:00 p.m.
