
By order dated June 12, 2015, I was assigned by the United States Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation to preside over pretrial proceedings with respect to the Lumber Liquidators Chinese-Manufactured Flooring Products Marketing, Sales Practices and Products Liability Litigation, MDL No. 2627. I have been advised by Defendants' counsel that the above-styled action is presently pending before you and that it is a case related to the MDL cases consolidated before me.

The purposes of this letter are to advise you of the ongoing MDL cases before me, the schedule currently in place with respect to those pretrial proceedings and the scope of those pretrial proceedings and to make available to you any aspects of those proceedings that may be of assistance or useful to you in resolving the matter before you. I also welcome any suggestions you may have as to how our proceedings may coordinate with your own in order to facilitate the efficient resolution of these related matters.

Attached are Pretrial Order #1, which sets forth the current overall case management schedule, and Pretrial Order #3, which adopts and establishes a protocol for the preservation of evidence.
