

ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

1 Parties

This contract is made between Airman Flight School inc. (herein after "School") and ZHCARIAS MOUSSAOUI (herein after "Student") on this date: 02/26/2001

2. Definitions:

- A. Aircraft time: Time flown in aircraft
- B. Dual Time: Flight Instructor Fee
- C. Simulator Time: Simulator Instruction
- D. Ground Instruction: Class room and individual instruction.

3. Resolutions/Premises:

- A. School desires Student to attain his/her educational requirements within the shortest period of time possible.
- B. School and Student state that both are lawfully capable of contracting. Neither party is below the age of majority, suffering from mental disease, and no duress or coercion has been exercised.
- C. School and Student state the object/thing contracted for is lawful.
- D. School and student state that sufficient consideration is present to bind each party to this contract.

4. Duties of School

- A. School will provide all training necessary for the student to obtain the certificates, ratings, or combination thereof contracted for by student. All training includes all aircraft time, dual time, ground time and simulator time required by the Federal Aviation Administration. The order of training and the type of training FAR-141 or FAR-61 is at the sole discretion of school.
- B. School will make every effort to meet the student's time constraints, however, due to student progress, weather conditions, and other factors beyond the school's control the school cannot and does not guarantee a completion date for the student's certificates or rating.

5. Duties of student:

- A. Student agrees to honor all internal rules promulgated by the school.
- B. Student agrees to care for the equipment, materials and tools belonging to the school.
- C. Student agrees to meet his/her financial obligations to the school.
- D. Student agrees to pay a \$25.00 NO SHOW FEE for missed flights or ground or simulator instruction (more than 3 NO SHOW FEES in any course will void the guarantee on that course).
- E. Student agrees to complete all home work and class assignments and to come to school on time (failure to adhere to this will result in the student being expelled from the school).

F. Student states that he/she reads writes and understands the English language. In the event the student is not proficient in English, then the student will be required to attend English classes, until he/she becomes proficient in English. The cost of this course is the students responsibility.

G: Student states that he/she is competent and current to exercise the privileges of the pilot certificate that they currently hold at the time of enrollment.

H. Student agrees that he/she must receive written permission from the Chief Flight Instructor prior to taking a leave of absence.

I. Student agrees that in the event of reckless operation of a School aircraft the student will be expelled from school and that no refund will be given. It is suggested the Student purchases their own non-owner insurance policy. There are several policies available

J. Student agrees that if the student leaves because of time constraints the student will have 90 days to return and complete training. Beyond this 90 day period the guarantee for that course is null and void.

K. Student agrees that in extreme instances that the school has the discretion to terminate training after 150% of minimums have been met.

L. Student agrees that due to volatil fuel prices that the School may institute a fuel surcharge. This charge will be posted daily.

Refund Policy:

If a student wishes to drop out of school before any flight or ground training has started the student will receive a 100% refund of the monies the student has paid less a 15% enrollment fee.

If a student drops out of school after training has begun all money will be refunded less materials, and less the invoices amount for training received. All student refunds will be available within a period of 30 days from the date the student drops out.

Student contracts for the following courses:PRIVATE PILOT at the agreed price of \$4,995.00 *Student will pay 1/3 of pri course now bal in 3 WKS. If student continues in further courses the pri is guaranteed. At this point student will pay 1/2 of bal. & the bal will be due*
