

## **STANDING ORDER**

Effective immediately, if all parties in a Social Security Appeal consent to have the matter heard by a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the matter shall be reassigned to United States Magistrate Judge Summer L. Speight for all purposes. If the parties do not consent to have the matter heard by a United States Magistrate Judge, the case shall be referred to Judge Speight for case management and resolution of nondispositive matters pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(A) and for a Report and Recommendation on dispositive matters pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B).

Let the Clerk publish this Standing Order on the Court's website and file this Standing Order electronically in current and future Social Security cases.
