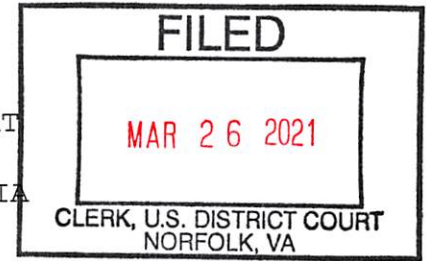

CJA COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT ORDER

On November 6, 2019, the Judicial Council of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit approved the Criminal Justice Act Plan ("CJA Plan") for the Eastern District of Virginia. Section VIII(A)(1) of the CJA Plan provides that the Court, in consultation with the Federal Public Defender, shall appoint three divisional CJA Committees that shall consist of one district judge, one magistrate judge, one federal public defender attorney, two CJA Panel attorneys and an *ex officio* staff member employed by the Clerk's Office. By order of December 18, 2019, the Court appointed divisional CJA Committees across the district for initial three-year terms. As contemplated by the CJA Plan, these terms will be staggered when reappointments/new appointments occur.

In the Alexandria Division, the Court initially appointed Richard Banke as the *Ex Officio* Staff Member of the Alexandria CJA Committee. However, as Richard Banke is no longer employed by the Court, Amanda Otto is hereby appointed to serve the remainder of the unexpired term for the *Ex Officio* Staff Member in the Alexandria Division effective immediately. Accordingly, the CJA

Committee shall consist of the following members in the Alexandria Division:
