STANDING ORDER

The judges in the Alexandria Division have met and agreed that counsel's access to the results of urine screens and forensic testing as well as to police offense reports is essential to prosecuting and defending charges of violating conditions of pretrial or post-conviction supervision. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that upon request of counsel of record, in preparation for a scheduled violation hearing, the United States Probation Office release to all counsel involved in the hearing, copies of the results of urine screens or other forensic testing and police offense reports.

The Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Order to the United States Probation Office, the Chief of the Criminal Division in the Alexandria United States Attorney's Office, and the Federal Public Defender.
