

**CJA COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT ORDER**

On November 6, 2019, the Judicial Council of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit approved the Criminal Justice Act Plan ("CJA Plan") for this Court. Section VIII(A)(1) of the CJA Plan provides that the Court, in consultation with the Federal Public Defender, shall appoint three divisional CJA Committees that shall consist of one district judge, one magistrate judge, one federal public defender attorney, two CJA Panel attorneys and an *ex officio* staff member employed by the Clerk's Office. The members of the respective CJA Committees in each division shall meet at least twice a year or as otherwise provided in the CJA Plan.

The Court entered its initial CJA Committee Appointment Order on December 18, 2019, appointing a CJA Committee effective January 1, 2020. Under the Plan, membership on the CJA Committee is for a term of three years, may be extended for an additional three years, and terms shall be staggered to ensure continuity. Therefore, in accordance with the Plan, **and effective January 1, 2023**, the following are hereby appointed to the CJA Committee in their respective divisions:
