REAPPOINTMENT OF UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE ROBERT J. KRASK

The current term of office of United States Magistrate Judge Robert J. Krask at Norfolk and Newport News, Virginia, is due to expire on September 1, 2023.
