

Social Security Cases

Revised effective February 25, 2008

Social Security cases filed on or after December 1, 2007, are electronic cases. All documents in these cases are to be filed electronically by counsel and are subject to the provisions of the court's *Electronic Case Filing Policies and Procedures* manual. The sealed administrative record is exempt from electronic filing.

Counsel of record are able to view the electronic documents in these cases. However, the general public is not able to view these electronic documents and can obtain through PACER only docket sheets and E-Government Act written opinions for these cases.

For these Social Security cases filed on or after December 1, 2007, those people who are not counsel of record who click on a document hyperlink will be informed that they do not have permission to view the document. They may still come to the Clerk's Office to view these documents on the public terminal.
